

## **INSTRUMENT OF GOVERNMENT: FEDERATED GOVERNING BODIES**

- 1 The name of the Federation is THE DEVON MOORS FEDERATION.
- 2 The names and categories of the schools in the Federation are:  
  
CHITTLEHAMPTON CHURCH OF ENGLAND (VA) PRIMARY SCHOOL  
COPPLESTONE FOUNDATION PRIMARY SCHOOL  
FILLEIGH FOUNDATION PRIMARY SCHOOL  
SPREYTON FOUNDATION PRIMARY SCHOOL
- 3 The name of the governing board is "THE GOVERNING BOARD OF THE DEVON MOORS FEDERATION".
- 4 The governing board shall consist of:
  - a two parent governors;
  - b one local authority governor;
  - c one staff governor;
  - d one headteacher;
  - e one co-opted governor;
  - f six foundation governors (one of whom shall be ex-officio) – see 6a) and 6 b) below.
- 5 Total number of governors twelve.
- 6 (a) Four Foundation governors shall be appointed by the Exeter Diocesan Board of Education, one of whom shall be Ex-officio.
- 6 (b) Two Foundation governors will be appointed by the Unites Schools Learning Partnership.
- 7 (a) The holder of the following office shall be a foundation governor ex-officio.  
  
The Principal Officiating Minister.  
  
(b) The Archdeacon of Barnstaple shall be entitled to appoint a foundation governor named in 6 (a) to act in the place of the ex-officio foundation governor whose governorship derives from the office named in 7 (a) above, in the event that the ex-officio foundation governor is unable or unwilling to act as a foundation governor or there is a vacancy in the office by virtue of which his/her governorship exists.

- 8 Exeter Diocesan Board of Education shall be entitled to request the removal of any ex-officio foundation governor and to appoint any substitute governor, in consultation with the Archdeacon named in 7 (b) above.
- 9 Chittlehampton Church of England (VA) Primary School was founded by Trust Deed.
- 10 Ethos Statement:
- Chittlehampton C of E (VA) Primary School is a Church of England school in the Diocese of Exeter.
- Recognising their historic foundation, the school will preserve and develop their religious character in accordance with the principles and practice of the Church of England and in partnership with the Churches in the parishes and the diocese.
- The school aims to serve their community by providing an education of the highest quality within the context of Christian belief and practice. They encourage an understanding of the meaning and significance of faith, and promote Christian values through the experiences they offer to all their pupils.
- 11 This Instrument of Government comes into effect on 1<sup>st</sup> February 2018.
- 12 This Instrument was made by order of Devon Local Authority on 22 January 2018.
