Notice is given in accordance with section 19(3) of the Education and Inspections Act 2006 and part 2 of schedule 1 to the School Organisation (Prescribed Alterations to Maintained Schools)(England) Regulations 2013 that: the Governing Board of Doddiscombsleigh Primary School intends to make a prescribed alteration to Doddiscombsleigh Primary School which is a community school located at Doddiscombsleigh, Exeter, Devon, EX6 7PR, 01647 252253, admin@doddi.devon.sch.uk

The proposed alteration is together with one or more of the proposed partners to acquire a trust established otherwise than under the School Standards and Framework Act 1998.

The name of the foundation will be United Schools' Learning Partnership and the proposed implementation date is 1 September 2018.


It is proposed that Doddiscombsleigh Primary School will become a member of the Trust. Doddiscombsleigh Primary School will nominate two trustees.

The Trust currently acts as a foundation for Ipplepen Primary School, Copplestone Primary School, Filleigh Community Primary School and Spreyton Primary School.

The partner in the Trust, nominating one trustee, is the co-operative movement, currently represented by the Co-operative College.

All parents/carers and learners attending a Trust school are eligible to become members of the Trust. This is also true of all members of staff employed by Trust schools and members of a range of community organisations supporting the work of the Trust. Family members of Doddiscombsleigh Primary School pupils and past pupils as well as individuals living or working locally who identify with what the trust is seeking to achieve can also join the Trust.
