

INSTRUMENT OF GOVERNMENT: FEDERATED GOVERNING BODIES

- 1 The name of the Federation is THE DEVON MOORS FEDERATION
- 2 The names and categories of the schools in the Federation are:

CLYST HYDON PRIMARY SCHOOL (Foundation)
COPPLESTONE PRIMARY SCHOOL (Foundation)
FILLEIGH PRIMARY SCHOOL (Foundation)
KILMINGTON PRIMARY SCHOOL (Community)
LYMPSTONE CHURCH OF ENGLAND (VC) PRIMARY SCHOOL (VC)
SHUTE PRIMARY SCHOOL (Community)
SPREYTON PRIMARY SCHOOL (Foundation)
UPOTTERY PRIMARY SCHOOL (Community)
- 3 The name of the governing body is "THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE DEVON MOORS FEDERATION".
- 4 The governing body shall consist of:
 - a two parent governors (one elected from each school within the federation);
 - b one local authority governor;
 - c one staff governor;
 - d one executive headteacher;
 - e four foundation governors – see 7 (a) and 7 (b) below
 - f five co-opted governors;
- 5 Total number of governors 14.
- 6 The term of office for all categories will be for four years with the exception of the executive headteacher by virtue of their office.
- 7 (a) Two foundation governors shall be appointed by Exeter Diocesan Board of Education
- (b) Two foundation governors shall be appointed by the United Schools Learning Partnership.
- 8 Lymptone Church of England (VC) Primary School was founded by Trust Deed.

9 Ethos Statement:

Lympstone C of E (VC) Primary School is a Church of England school in the Diocese of Exeter.

Recognising their historic foundation, the school will preserve and develop their religious character in accordance with the principles and practice of the Church of England and in partnership with the Churches in the parishes and the diocese.

The school aims to serve their community by providing an education of the highest quality within the context of Christian belief and practice. They encourage an understanding of the meaning and significance of faith, and promote Christian values through the experiences they offer to all their pupils.
